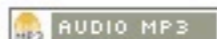

- A story in three movements
- Israel prepares to enter the land (1-12)
- Israel punished with wilderness wanderings (13-19)
- Israel prepares to enter the land (20-36)

Deuteronomy

- The retelling of the Covenant Law to Israel as they readied to enter the land of Canaan.
